17 Acute and Chronic Care Measures

Medication Adherence – Proportion of Days Covered

- Oral Diabetes
- Hypertension (ACE or ARB)
- Cholesterol (Statins)

Diabetes Care

- Urine Protein Screening
- HbA1c Testing
- Eye Exam

Annual Monitoring for Persistent Medications

- Digoxin
- ACE/ARB
- Diuretics

Other Acute and Chronic Care Management

- Appropriate Testing for Children with Pharyngitis
- Appropriate Treatment for Children with Upper Respiratory Infection
- Osteoporosis Management in Women who had a Fracture
- Persistence of Beta-Blocker Treatment after a Heart Attack
- Arthritis: Disease Modifying Anti-Rheumatic Drug (DMARD) Therapy in RA
- Use of Appropriate Medications for People with Asthma
- New Episode of Depression: Effective Acute Phase Treatment
- New Episode of Depression: Effective Continuation Phase Treatment

7 Preventive Care Measures

Pediatric Prevention

- Childhood Immunization Status: MMR
- Childhood Immunization Status: VZV
- Well-Child Visits Ages 0-15 Months
- Well-Child Visits Ages 3-6 Years Old
- Well-Child Visits Ages 12-21 Years Old

Adult Prevention

- Breast Cancer Screening
- Cervical Cancer Screening

3 Utilization Measures

Potentially Avoidable ER visits

- Based on an NYU algorithm; tier 1 diagnoses with highest probability for being avoidable

Admissions for Ambulatory Sensitive Admissions

- An AHQR specification that includes:
 - Angina
 - Asthma / Bronchitis
 - COPD
 - Dehydration
 - Diabetes
 - Heart Failure
 - Hypertension
 - Urinary Tract Infection
 - Pneumonia

Generic Drug Dispensing Rate for Five Classifications

- Statins
- ADHD Medications
- ARBs and ARB Combos
- Beta Blockers and Beta Blocker Combos
- Serotonin Agonists (Migraine)
