





Patients reported they would have used the following, if not LHO:




- Retail Health is 1.14x as expensive as LHO

Therefore, members and employers save an average of \$201* per episode (including follow-up) for the most commonly treated conditions








Last 6 months (11/15-4/16)

Mental health in America - Depression

Depression is the #1 contributor to disability in the U.S., and one of the most costly health conditions for American employers:

- Nearly 63% of the annual \$83 billion associated with depression is due to workplace losses
- More than \$44 billion per year in lost productivity in the workplace can be attributed to absenteeism and presenteeism
- Workers with depression are often unable to accomplish as many tasks or perform at as high a level as workers without

Telehealth: for Behavioral Health

Convenience and access to online behavioral health visits encourage consumers to get the care they need.

The change in patients that participate in a regular depression management program - 8.2% greater productivity and 28.4% less absenteeism over two years compared to patients who do not regularly participate.*

The reduction in absenteeism and the increase in productivity had an **estimated annual value** of **\$2,601** per full-time equivalent employee (\$1,982 for improved productivity and \$619 for reduced absenteeism).**
