

What is Non-Essential?

Definition: Not Essential, Not Necessary

PBM Related Version: Me Too, Egregious, Gratuitous, Uncalled-For, Unwarranted, Inappropriate, Gimmick, DUMB

Jeff: Medications with no essential clinical need or unique use when compared to more cost effective available alternatives.

What is Non-Essential?

- Patent Extenders (Nexium/Dexilant, ER/XR)
 * Revenue Loss/Rebate Pressure
- 2) Brands with a Generic (Lipitor/Crestor, Wellbutrin)
- 3) New Delivery/Version (Glumetza, Pennsaid)
- 4) New Combinations (Duexis, Yosprala/Durlaza)
- 5) Overpriced Generic (Metformin OSM, Omeprazole Bicarb)
- 6) Compound Pharmacy Mitigation (Diclofenac, Lidocaine)
- 7) Dermatology Oral (Absorica, Solodyne)
- 8) Dermatology Topical (Onexton, Alpawash)
- 9) FDA Not Approved (Donnatal, Librax)
- * Aggressive marketing, cold calling, pharmacy partners, and <u>coupons, coupons, coupons.</u>

Why Worry about Non-Essential?



DUEXIS® (ibuprofen and famotidine) Tablets 800 mg/26.6 mg

2016 Annual Usage

- \$1,600 Per Script
- Replace with Ibuprofen/Pepcid \$30



2016 Annual Usage

- \$1,800 Per Script
- Generic Naproxen/Prilosec \$30

Sample client with a Union spend \$450,000 on these 2 drugs alone. Requires EDUCATION!

- Report summary of impacted claims and savings opportunity
- Savings avg. range avg. 2%-7% of plan cost
