#### **Navigating to Indiana Farm Bureau Insurance Building**

To get to the Indiana Farm Bureau Insurance Building, please navigate to "Indiana Farm Bureau Insurance Building 46202". Enter the parking lot via circular drive in the front of the building from S. East Street. Guests can park on either the north or south parking lot at no charge. Enter the building through the front doors and go to the security desk to the right to check-in. Attempting to drive to the 225 S East Street address, will direct guests to the back of the building where parking is strictly for employees. ## **Overflow Parking at Indiana Farm Bureau Insurance Building**

If parking is unavailable in the front lot, please use the 610 E Georgia St Parking lot pictured below on the north side of the building. The gate arms will be closed, so to enter please buzz in at the intercom and the security team can give guests access.
