MAINE

- 1. The Maine Health Care Claims Database is maintained by the Maine Health Data Organization.

- 3. The public use data and report over prescription drug costs and utilization can be found at: https://mhdo.maine.gov/tableau/prescriptionReports.cshtml
 - a. Publicly available data includes the 25 most costly drugs in the state, 25 most frequently prescribed drugs in the state, and the 25 drugs with the highest year over year cost increases for the state.
 - b. For other data sets, a data request needs to be submitted through the MHDO's request portal; data request fees are determined based on the level of claims data requested.
- 4. Health insurance claims information are collected from commercial insurance carriers, TPAs, PBMs, dental benefit administrators, Maine Medicaid, and Medicare. Health care claims processors must submit periodically a completed health care claims data set for all Maine resident members.
